

2008 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT

Monday May 12, 2008

To: Ernest N. Steward Jr., a constable of the Town of Livermore Falls, in the County of Androscoggin, in the State of Maine:

Greeting:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of the Town of Livermore Falls in the County of Androscoggin, in the State of Maine, qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Livermore Falls Municipal Building in said Town of Livermore Falls on Monday, the 12th day of May A.D. 2008 at 6:30 in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles to wit:

Article 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2. Shall the Town of Livermore Falls vote to approve a Community Development Block Grant application for the Community Enterprise Grant program in the amount of \$150,000, and to submit same to the Department of Economic and Community Development and if said program is approved, to authorize the municipal officers to accept said grant funds, to make such assurances, assume such responsibilities, and exercise such authority as are necessary and reasonable to implement such programs. Furthermore, the Town of Livermore Falls is cognizant of the requirement that should the intended National Objective of the CDBG program not be met all CDBG funds must be repaid to the State of Maine CDBG program.



Article 3. Shall the town vote to ratify the existing overdrafts in the FY 2007/2008 Administration and Buildings Accounts totaling \$9,017, and appropriate from unappropriated surplus \$3,416 for Administration and \$5,601 for buildings to cover these overdrafts.

Article 4. Shall the town vote to transfer and appropriate the sum of \$30,000 from unappropriated surplus to the Public Works Account.
